



“Ignis” Earrings

Material (for pair of earrings):

Z Beads 10mm (4 pcs)

Miyuki Round 11/0 (approx 0.3 gram)

Miyuki Round 15/0 (approx 0.2 gram)

Matubo Gemduo (2 pcs)

Matubo 8/0 (4 pcs)

3mm firepolished beads (8 pcs)

Jump rings, earring findings of your choice

Optional: embellishment (tassels, drop-shaped beads, jewelry chain)

Beading needle and thread (Nymo, Fireline...)

Difficulty: For beginners/intermediate

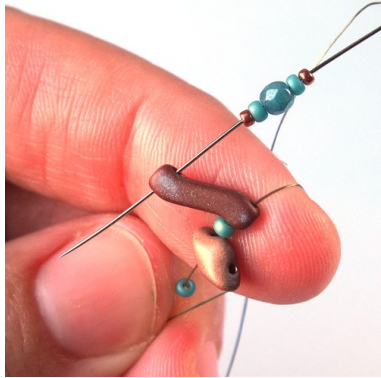




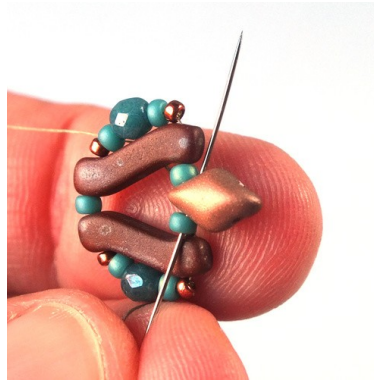
1) String one 11/0, one Gemduo, one 11/0 and one Z bead (from the inside, as shown in the photo). Slide the beads to the end of the thread (you can use a bead stopper at the end so the beads don't spill).



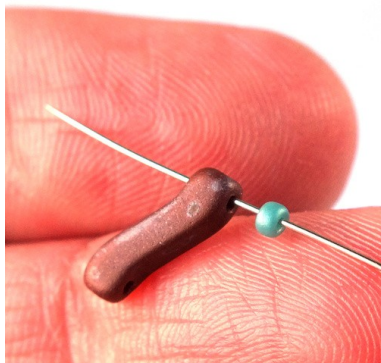
6) If using the bead stopper, remove it now. Then tie both ends of the thread together using a square knot. This is what you should get.



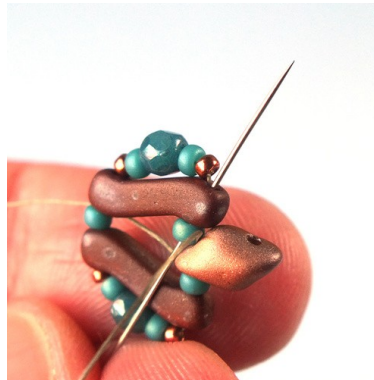
2) Add one 15/0, one 11/0, one 3mm FP, one 11/0 and one 15/0 and pass back through the other hole of the Z bead.



7) Pass through the next 11/0, upper hole of the Gemduo ...



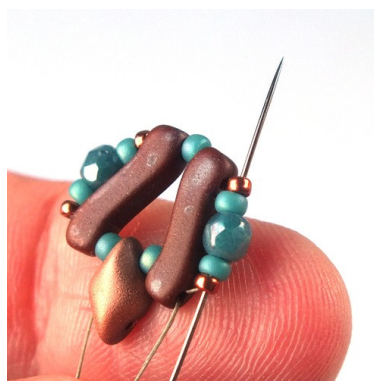
3) Add one 11/0 and one Z bead (from the outside - as shown in the photo).



8) ... another 11/0 and the nearest hole of the next Z bead ...



4) Slide the new beads down to the previous ones.



9) ... and through the next group of (15/0, 11/0, 3mm FP, 11/0, 15/0).



5) Add one 15/0, one 11/0, one 3mm FP, one 11/0 and one 15/0 and pass back through the other hole of the Z bead.



10) Add three 15/0s and one 11/0 and pass through the 11/0 between the Z beads.



11) Add one 11/0 and three 15/0s and pass through the next group of (15/0, 11/0, 3mm FP, 11/0, 15/0).



16) Pass through the next group of (15/0, 11/0, 3mm FP, 11/0, 15/0) ...



12) Add three 15/0s, one 11/0 and one 3mm FP and pass through the free hole of the next Gemduo.



17) ... and also through the next three 15/0s, one 11/0 and one 3mm FP



13) Add one 3mm FP, one 11/0 and three 15/0s and pass through the next group of (15/0, 11/0, 3mm FP, 11/0, 15/0).



18) Add one 15/0, one 11/0, one 8/0, one 11/0 and one 15/0 and pass through the next 3mm FP, one 11/0 and three 15/0s



14) Then pass through the next three 15/0s and one 11/0.



19) Weave through the entire row ...



15) Add one 8/0. Skip the "lower" 11/0 and pass through the next 11/0 and three 15/0s.



20) ... one more time ...



21) ... but when you exit from the 11/0 before the newly-added 8/0 ...



22) ... skip the 8/0 and then pass through the next 11/0 and all the following beads. Keep your tension as tight as possible.



23) Then tie a few half-hitch knots and cut off all the remaining thread.



24) Use jump rings to attach earring findings and optionally some embellishment to the earring.
