
"ILSA" EARRINGS


Material (for one pair of earrings):
Matubo Rulla (42 pcs)
Matubo 7/0 (6 pcs)
Pinch Beads (24 pcs)
Toho 15/0 (48 pcs)
Small Dagger Beads 3x11mm (4 pcs)
Big Dagger Beads 5x16mm (2 pcs)
Jump rings (4 pcs)
Eyepins 50mm (2 pcs)
Studs or any other earring component of your choice (2 pcs)

Beading needle size 10 to 12
Beading thread (Nymo, S-lon, Fireline)
Pliers - flush-cutter, flat-nose, round-nose

Difficulty: For beginners / intermediate
Note before you start: Keep the tense of the thread quite tough all the time to keep the beads together.


1) Thread your needle with a comfortable length of thread (approx.. 75 cm ) and string $1 x$ 15/0, 1x Rulla, 1x 15/0, $1 \times$ Rulla... 5 pcs of each in total.

2) Repeat step 54 more times to finish this row. Pass the needle through the first Pinch bead of this row.
3) Exiting Pinch bead, pick up $1 \times 15 / 0$, $1 x$ Pinch bead, $1 \times 15 / 0$ and pass the needle through the same Pinch bead (make a little loop above Pinch bead). Pass the needle through the next Rulla and Pinch bead.
4) Repeat step 74 more times.
Pass the needle through the next Rulla, 15/0 and Pinch bead of this row.
5) Exiting Pinch bead, pick up $1 \times$ Rulla and pass the needle through the next Pinch bead.
6) Repeat step 94 more times to finish this row. Pass the needle through the first Rulla of this row. Make step up up as in step 2 (pass the needle through the upper hole of the same Rulla).

7) Repeat step 114 more times to finish this row. Pass the needle through the first Rulla of this row. Make step up as in step 2 (pass the needle through the upper hole of the same Rulla).
8) Exiting the upper hole of Rulla, pick up $1 \times 15 / 0$ and pass the needle through the upper hole of the next Rulla.
9) Repeat step 134 more times to finish this row. Pass the needle through the first $15 / 0$ of this row.
10) To finish the beaded bead, pass the thread through all beads of the last row couple of times and then to fix and form whole bead together pass the needle through all beads of the beaded bead.

11) Pull your thread firmly and tie an overhead knot between every two or three beads as you work. Trim the working thread. Do the same with the other end of the thread.
12) Thread your needle with a comfortable length of thread and, leaving a 20 cm tail, pick up $1 \times$ Rulla, 1xPinch bead, $1 \times$ Small Dagger, 1xBig Dagger, 1xSmall Dagger, 1xPinch bead and pass the needle through the second hole of Rulla.
13) Exiting Rulla, pick up $2 \times 15 / 0,1 \times 7 / 0,2 \times 15 / 0$. Make a square knot and pass the needle through all beads again to finish a shape. Tie an overhead knot between every two or three beads as you work. Trim the working thread. Do the same with the other end of the thread.
14) Using an eyepin pick up $1 \times 7 / 0$ and $1 \times$ Pinch bead and pass it through the beaded bead.
Then pick up $1 x$ Pinch bead and $1 \times 7 / 0$ and make a plain loop on the other end.
15) Using jump rings connect one end of the beaded bead with the little pendant (connect the plain loop and $7 / 0$ ) and the other end of the beaded bead with an earring finding.

Repeat steps 1 to 20 to make the second earring.
